

**FAQs on the applicability of CPE Credit hours on different Learning Activities.
Clarification received by IBBI relating to the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India
(Continuing Professional Education for Insolvency Professionals) Guidelines, 2019.**

1	<p><i>“An IP may earn credit hours from the learning activities by participation in learning activities offered by the Board, an IPA, a Registered Valuer Organization, a statutory professional institute, a university, or any other entity, as may be approved by the Board from time to time”.</i></p> <p>It is not clear that which are the statutory professional institute, university or other entities approved by the board.</p>	<p>‘statutory professional institute’ means any institute created by statute to regulate a profession, like ICAI, ICSI, and ICAI (cost).</p> <p>‘university’ means an university as defined in the University Grants Commission Act, 1956.</p> <p>‘any other entity as approved by the Board’ means an entity approved by the IBBI to conduct CPE. Till date only IICA has been granted approval by the board with effect 19th April 2021.</p>
2	<p>Whether Certificate Courses conducted by Statutory professional Institutes/ Universities are eligible for CPE Hours.</p>	<p>Yes, the same are eligible for CPE, subject to the condition that the subject of learning activity is in the areas relevant for IPs, an indicative list of which is at Schedule to these Guidelines.</p>
3	<p>Whether publication of an article in online website can be equated to publication of article in journal. Further please clarify which journals qualify as referred national or international journals.</p>	<p>Publication of articles on websites is not considered.</p> <p>‘Referred journal’ means a journal which publishes article selected through a peer review process.</p>
4	<p>Whether contribution of an article in a publication of a statutory professional institute like ICAI, ICSI, and ICAI (cost) is eligible for the purpose granting CPE.</p>	<p>NO CPE will be eligible for the contribution in the publication, as per the provisions of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Continuing Professional Education for Insolvency Professionals) Guidelines, 2019.</p>
5	<p>Whether the round table is eligible for the purpose of claiming CPE Hours.</p>	<p>Yes, provided it meets the norms of CPE.</p>
