The insolvency profession is required to be more responsive as insolvencies are expected to rise, post lifting of suspension placed during Covid Period. Among many measures announced by Govt. include pre-pack insolvency framework which allow stakeholders to negotiate terms out of court and achieve resolution faster. IBBI is also working on other frameworks including on group insolvency and cross border insolvency. Moreover, individual insolvency in the full-fledged format, is touted as next big thing within insolvency regime.

To facilitate and equip the IPs, especially with smaller practices, to face newer challenges and build their capacity, IIIPI had recently constituted a study group of Insolvency Professionals, chaired by IP & CA Subodh Kr. Agarwal, to deliberate and recommend measures to 'Enhance Roles of Small Sized IPs'. The study group has recently concluded and submitted its report.
